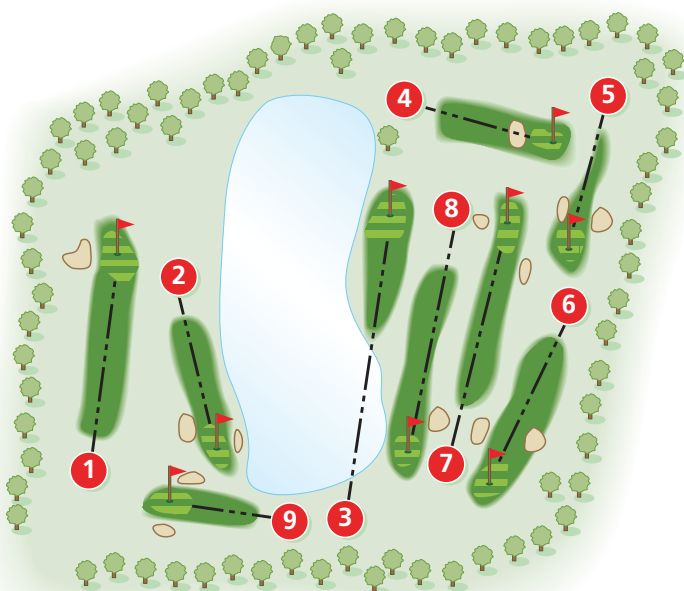


Willows Edge Golf Course

A great opportunity to improve your short game or warm up for the Championship Course. The course design and layout, set in the peaceful parkland setting of Crondon Valley, provides an excellent challenge for all levels of skill and ability.

Ideal for all the family's competitive fun with a variation of holes, ranging from 70-150 yards, that are bordered by trees, strategically placed sand bunkers and some water hazards

Local rules

1. Out of bounds (Rule 27)

White posts define the Out of Bounds and must not be moved. A ball finishing on or beyond any fence or hedge defining the perimeter of the course (including the perimeter of the Willows Edge course and the area of the clubhouse and its surrounds), or any areas of the marked with white posts, is OOB.

Additional marked OOBs: beyond the hedge running to the left of the 1st tee down to the ditch; through the back of the 4th green; to the left of the 9th fairway; to the right of the 16th tee when playing the 16th hole; through the back of the 18th green.

2. Water hazards (Rule 26-1)

Water hazards marked by yellow stakes or unmarked are ordinary water hazards. Lateral Water Hazards are marked with red stakes. If your ball finds any water hazard on the 4th or 14th holes, the next shot may be played from the designated dropping zone, under penalty of one shot. The ditch between the 10th and 11th holes is a Lateral Water Hazard.

3. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)

All areas appropriately marked or sign posted; tyre ruts (not faint tyre impressions) through the green.

4. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).

5. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

Any artificially surfaced road or path, or man-made fence that is not part of the boundary of the course; staked trees (not banded); fixed sprinkler heads; the 100/150/200 yard fairway markers.

Etiquette

Your place on the course is immediately behind the group in front, not just in front of the group behind. Please replace all divots, repair pitch marks, rake bunkers after use, and switch off mobile phones while you are on the course. Please also respect the white lines around the greens, and keep buggies and trolleys outside the area they define.

Please replace divots, repair pitchmarks and rake bunkers. Avoid slow play.
